We spend almost one third of our lives sleeping. Yet only within the last four decades have scientist begun to study, understand, and demystify what goes on when we sleep. The traditional modern view is that sleep represents a stage of renewal, where the body repairs and restores worn-out tissues and cells. There is some truth to this, but we now know that the body is restoring itself when it is awake as well. People used to think that sleep was a period of total inactivity for the body. We now know that a complicated web of chemical interactions occurs while we sleep. The brain, rather than shutting itself off, registers a whole series of electrochemical changes.
